**Minimum 6 participants – Maximum 10 participants*

**To ensure Safe Guide ratio and minimum, this may be a selection*

**Open to Guiders, Guiders with girls OR girls on own*

What – backpacking overnight adventure

Where – to Cheakamus Lake, Garibaldi Park

**to give you a guideline...the gathering time on the Saturday will be approximately 10am
but this time could change slightly depending on where participants are coming from
(to match up with ferry travel etc.)*

Fee - \$25 per person (*covers campsite fee, food samples, rentals etc*)
