EMERGENCY FIRST AID – Community Care (1 day)

- 3 year certificate
- required by many Yellow Level Activities (sleepovers, camps)
- includes CPR for children and adults

Times – 8:30 am to 5:30 pm

Fee - (includes workbook and certificate)

STANDARD FIRST AID (2 days)

NOTE - January 21 & 22 is now FULL

- 3 year certificate
- required for Red Level Activities (adventure)
- includes CPR for infants, children and adults

Dates – Saturday, February 25 & Sunday, February 26 *****NEW DATES*****

**deadline to register February 10th*

Times – 8:30 am to 4:30 pm (both days)

Fee - \$128 (includes workbook and certificate)

FEES

Districts have financial policies that help support training for adult members.

STEP 1

Ask your District Commissioner about both financial support *and* your responsibility for attendance once you have registered and the registration deadline has passed...

STEP 2

2) Register before the registration deadline (min 8/max 14)

Your District Commissioner will be advised that you have registered for first aid training. You are responsible for paying the fee or portion to your District (you do not pay St. John Ambulance). Your District will be invoiced for your fee.
