GUIDE CAMP SKILLS DAY

For Guides & their Guiders

Location – Cates Park, Deep Cove

9am to 4pm

This all-day outdoor training is targeted towards first-year Guide-age girls and is an annual favourite!

Guiders and girls will rotate through a ‘hands-on’ round robin of training opportunities that will cover camp cooking with yummy tasters (*always a hit with both girls & leaders!*), shelters, tents, stoves & lanterns as well as fire lighting!

You will want these skills so that you can try them out at your Spring tenting camp!

This is a fun full-day spent in the outdoors and for many...this will be their first experience!

An important part of camp skills training is learning how to stay warm and dry...no matter what the weather! Before attending Guide Camp Skills Day, we will help you ‘prepare’ yourself and the girls for a day outdoors through a series of preparatory emails or ‘baby steps’.

Guiders must provide supervision (minimum and ratio) throughout the activity and have a First Aider (*please see the First Aid page for training dates*).
Come to participate and learn with the girls!

There is a \$10 fee per girl for this training (no fee for Guiders providing ratio/minimum)
